

Thank you for participating in the Horizon Europe Cluster 6 info webinar

Two questions were raised during the webinar:

First, there were uncertainty when calls of European partnerships, which support public-public partnerships, provide funding for third parties. Academy of Finland and Finnish ministeries are tentatively committed to the first three partnerships (biodiversity, water, blue economy). However, the call process for these partnerships is only about to begin, and thus we don't know yet when these partnerships will organize transnational joint calls. Academy of Finland and ministeries will of course inform about these calls on their webpages later on.

Secondly, there was a question how companies find partners/can join Horizon Europe projects. Enterprise Europe Network is a network providing expertise and internationalization services for SMEs. The national network of Finland includes three organisations, which assist companies in finding potential R&D partners using the Enterprise Europe Network (more information can be found here: <https://www.een.fi/en/contact/>). In addition, when the Horizon Europe calls will be published, you can find topic dedicated partner search from there.
