
Distributed Ledger Technologies Are Not the Silver Bullet

These four conditions should apply for DLT to be useful:

- 1. Shared database between multiple parties
- 2. Absence of **trust** ("trustless")
- 3. Need explicit consensus
 - Conflicting transactions must be resolved
- 4. Desirability for **no intermediation**
 - E.g. issues with trust or cost structure
