Horizon 2020 – what and why?

- Develop new innovative product-, service- or business conceps for international markets!
- Make new and challenging research together with international cooperation partners!
- Have an influence on your own operational environment in Europe!

Call examples 2020 (€ tbc):

Food security, agriculture, forestry, water research and bioeconomy (SC2) - 484 M€

- Sustainable Food Security healthy food from land and sea, resource efficiency & environmental perfomance of food systems, fighting the impact of climate change, GHG emission and air pollutants (155 M€)
- Blue Growth harvesting potential of waters, protecting biodiversity, enhancing climate resilience (51 M€)
- Rural Renaissance new value chains and business models in rural areas (78 M€)
- Food and natural resources (bridging towards "Horizon Europe") new part in WP complementing calls above, incl. also biobased products (200 M€)

Climate action, environment, resource efficiency and raw materials (SC5) – 376,5 M€

• Greening the economy in line with the Sustainable Development Goals (SDGs) – enhancing circular economy; improving efficiency of resource use (incl. energy and water), combining economic and environmental benefits etc. (187 M€).

Nano- and biotechnology, advanced materials and processing (NMBP) - 601,1 M€

• Open Innovation Test Beds for nano-enabled biobased materials (111,5 M€), Upcycling Bioplastics of food and drinks packaging (20 M€), Industrial sustainability (219,1 M€)

INVESTMENT AND DEVELOPMENT GRANTS FOR CIRCULAR ECONOMY SOLUTIONS — CALL OPEN

THE MINISTRY OF ECONOMIC AFFAIRS AND EMPLOYMENT



- The call aims to boost investments in and development on novel circular economy technologies, processes, networked solutions, and service models.
- The solutions should clearly facilitate the breakthrough of the circular economy in Finland.
- Call is mainly targeted to companies.
- Possible funding 50 % of development costs and 25 % of investment costs (total funding max. 200 000 euros)
- Grants are awarded continuously to projects with impact on future growth of circular economy.
- Also funding from Business Finland available for companies and networks.


