

OVERVIEW

In terms of total orders for new ships Japan was in 3rd position during the end of year 2019. In light of big mergers in China and South Korea, the Japanese Central Government, lead by MLIT, is currently thinking about merging the 15 largest shipbuilders in Japan into one big group, in order to compete more effectively in the global market.
