












17 Administrative Areas7 Major Metropolitan Cities






Key points

- Stable growth of overnight stays
 - Visitors doubled since 2014, but 2019 forecast gloomy
- Finland (and whole Nordics) considered mainly as summer destination
 - Long-distance travel considerably lower in winter season, affects whole Europe
- Finland is leading the Nordics in winter season overnights, but 2nd year-round (Norway 1st)
- Finland as a destination is often combined with other Nordics, or Russia
- Traveler profiles:
 - 54% FIT, 27% Business, 15% Groups *Winter season 2018
- Busan-Helsinki direct route by Finnair to be operated 3 times a week, launching March 2020


Korean overnight stays in Finland

Korean visitors by profile (1+ nights)














RATIO BY SUBJECT





미국에서 가장 유명한 건축을 중의 하나인 국회의사당 국회의사당 건물은 내셔널 몰이 내려다보이는 곳에 자리 잡고 있습니다. 미국에서 가장 유명한 건축을 중의 하나. 사당의 돔은 마치 건물이 왕관을 쓰고 있는 것 같은 모습을 하고 있습니다. 건물의 초석은 1793년 조지 워싱턴이 서 웠습니다. 맞은편 좌측이 상원, 우측이 하원이 사용하고 있습니다. 정 중앙의 기둥은 높이는 약 77m이고, 그 꼭대기에 유의 여신이 서 있습니다. 그리고 기둥의 제일 아래 로돈다(Rotunda:돔아래 부분)의 벽에는 미국이 자랑하는 위인 들과 콜롬버스의 신대륙 상륙, 독립선언 등의 미국 역사에 대해 그린 유화가 전시되고 있습니다. 방문객들은 무료 가 드 투어에 참여해 의사당을 둘러보거나 개별적으 . 테퍼슨 기념관은 지붕이 이오니아식 돔 구조로 된 원형 건축물로 신고전 낭만주의 양식의 표본입니다. 워싱턴을 대 표하는 유명 건축을 중의 하나로 국립 미습관을 만든 건축가인 존 러셀 포프(John Russell Pope)가 만들었습니다. 마 국립 기념물로 지정되어 있으며, 루즈벨트 대통령 때 착공해 1943년에 완공되었습니다. 건물 안에는 대륙회의에서 연설하고 있는 제퍼슨의 동상이 있습니다. 그는 위대한 정치가이자 과학자였고, 정치에 대한 확고한 철학을 가지고 있었던. 미국독립선언서를 만든 주요 집필진 중의 한 사람이었습니다. 이 기념관은 제3대 대통령이었던 토머스 제표 미국 달러가 만들어지는 장소로 지폐와 관련된 다양한 체험이 가능한 곳 워싱턴에 위치한 조폐공사는 미국 달러가 만들어지는 장소로, 우리나라의 조폐 공사라고 할 수 있는 아주 중요한 곳 입니다. 워싱턴 DC 조폐국을 찾아가면 1달러 32장을 엮은 지폐와 같이 다양한 형태의 지폐들을 기념으로 구입할 수 있으며 더불어 지폐가 만들어지는 장면들을 견학을 통해 직접 볼 수 있는 체험을 할 수 있습니다. 조폐국 시설 견학은 오전 9시부터 오후 2시까지 할 수 있으며 다른 시설보다 출입 보안 검사가 철저한 곳입니다. 유리창을 통해 조페와 ? 련된 다양한 작업 괴정을 볼 수 있고 진열장을 통해 화폐의 역사를 한눈에 볼 수 있는 좋은 경험을 할 수 있습니다. 세계 최대의 석조탑, 워싱턴 기념탑 미국의 대통령들 중에서 가장 사랑받고 청송받고 있는 초대 대통령 조지 워싱턴의 업적을 기리기 위해 세워진 세계 최대의 석조탑으로 높이 166m의 화강암 오벨리스크입니다. 1848년에 착공하였으나 남북전쟁으로 1884년에 완성도 었습니다. 정상의 전망대에 엘리베이터로 올라갈 수 있으며, 70초 정도 소요됩니다.

Confucian Roots

- Even modern Korean society is influence by the Confucian philosophy
- Hierarchical society age, ranks, job titles
- Importance of building personal relationships and network No cold-calls, meetings through 3rd party acquiantaces
- Strict manners and etiquette

Dynamic and fast-moving business culture — keywords:

- Straightforward
- Proceeding Fast "Balli Balli Culture" Prompt responses & follow-up expected
- Details are important
- Trust is the Key
- Long-term Partnership (Exclusivity)
- Price sensitive



4. Korea Business Culture and manner

Basic Manners

- Bowing slightly
- Addressing with proper professional titles when possible
- Know the hierarchical order
- Handshake with men, bow with females
- Giving and receiving with two hands

Business Cards

- Representation of the person Must have!
- Exchanged as the first greeting, examine thoroughly
- Use two hands and treat with care
- Placed on table during meeting, not pocket

Business Attire

- More formal than western countries in general
- <u>Males:</u> Dark-colored suits are the norm (tie optional), juniors dress more formal
- <u>Females:</u> Sleeveless tops, short skirts, and low necklines should be avoided

*** Business Gifts**

- Not a must, but common and considered a good manner
- Modest value (esp. Media, public organizations)
- Especially gifts from Finland recommended
- Given at the end of the meeting to person of highest rank

Business Meetings

- Make appointments well in advance
- Punctuality
- Don't expect decisions to be made during meetings
- Facts and figures appreciated

*** Language**

- English speaking level generally average
- Often junior employees do the translating for senior executives
- Talk simple, short, and slow to be clear
- Counter-part might not show it if they didn't understand

Hospitality

- Offering lunch or dinner with drinks to foreign partners is considered good manners
- Avoid small-talk about sensitive topics (politics, religion, historical issue)
- Don't be surprised by highly personal questions (age, family, hometown)
