

EXCELLENT INFRASTRUCTURE FOR BUSINESS

Finland's advanced transport infrastructure and logistics are a key strength of the domestic economy and a catalyst for the country's lively trade with the Nordic and Baltic countries, the EU, Russia and Asia.

Finland ranks 13th out of 160 countries in the Logistics Performance Index 2018 comparison and number one in tracking & tracing category. This is a good proof of the consistent work, which has been done in Finland in order to reach the high level of logistics services and the reliability of supply chains.

GATEWAY BETWEEN EAST AND WEST

Finnish business and commercial life is served by an excellent network of roads, railways, waterways, canals and sea lanes. Because of its geographical location at the eastern fringe of the EU, Finland is the natural and ideal business gateway to Russia. The two countries share the same rail gauge, so rail cars do not require any technical modifications or reloading when they cross the border.

Finland has 24 airports for freight and passenger transport, including the Helsinki-Vantaa Airport. In 2020 SKYTRAX World Airport Awards recognized this airport as number one in Northern Europe.





Finland's fully automated, state-ofthe-art ports are highly specialised and rank among the safest and fastest in the world. Car ferries and container ships serve the region with regular daily departures. The strategic Vuosaari Harbour in Helsinki provides efficient transport connections to a market area of some 80 million consumers.

SMART TRAFFIC SERVICES BETWEEN HELSINKI AND ST PETERSBURG

The E18 motorway or the Northern Growth Corridor links the cities of Oslo, Stockholm, Turku, Helsinki and St Petersburg and bring economic benefits, technological innovations as well as ecological and state-of-the-art transport services to Finland. The route was re-opened in 2018.

CONSTANTLY DEVELOPING HELSINKI-VANTAA AIRPORT – ONE OF THE BEST IN THE WORLD

The Helsinki-Vantaa Airport offers global connections to about 140 international destinations, and has became a popular gateway to Asia. Currently there are 21 direct flights to Asia, the Middle East, and North America.

At the airport you can also find one of the most modern and one of the world's newest air cargo hubs. Finnair Cargo COOL Nordic terminal focuses on temperature-sensitive and high-value cargo shipments between Europe and Asia. Finnair was the first airline in the world to be awarded the prestigious CEIV pharma certificate by IATA.

Airport Development Programme at the Helsinki-Vantaa airport continues despite of Covid19 crisis, as it is a long-term investment that aims to provide air passengers with a good level of service and offer airlines the capacity they need far into the future.
