Connecting Europe Facilities – CEF

2014 - 2020 Multiannual financing framework for CEF

Total €30.4 billion of that:

€23.7 billion for Transport (including cohesion envelope €11.3 billion),

€4.7 billion for Energy, and

€0.5 billion for Telecom

2021 -2027 Multiannual financing framework for CEF2

Proposed by the Commission will be decided in the MFF process and may be decreased!

Total for Transport €30.6 billion of that

€12.8 billion for general envelope,

€11.3 billion for cohesion envelope and

€6.5 billion for military mobility

€8,7 billion for energy

€3,0 billion or digital
