What an NCP Can Do 4 You? (1)

- ✓To inform and to provide general and specific info about calls, conditions and offer Commission's <u>annotated</u> info.
- ✓ To assist, advise and train e.g. about project submission, budgeting and reporting. Offers project <u>pre-proposal check &</u> <u>pitching coaching</u>.
- ✓ All difficult questions are welcome since NCP has <u>direct</u> <u>contacts</u> to solve them from European Commission.
- ✓ Signposting and cooperation with other funding opportunities (national & international).



What an NCP Can Do 4 You? (2)

- ✓ Finnish NCPs act as a co-delegate and expert members in different theme focused <u>committees</u> (e.g. ICT, Health, Security) in order to provide hints where EC R&D&I activities, funding instruments and conditions are evolving.
- ✓ Business Finland has close cooperation nationally between Academy of Finland, VTT, Sitra, different ministries and key stakeholders to affect e.g. Finnish proposal bilateral discussions with Commission and to join forces with other delegates/NCPs.

FINLAND What an NCP Can Do 4 You? (3)

- ✓ Possibility to use <u>national voice</u> to foster Finnish research and innovation in the short term & in the long run (2021-2027).
- ✓NCP can provide call statistics, conclusions and reasons behind success rates. NCP has the access to all proposal <u>Evaluation Summary Reports</u> which provide valuable information about different consortia and lessons to learn.
- ✓ Business Finland NCPs have the access to Business Finland <u>customer portfolio</u> (research and corporate projects) which helps to build either domestic and international consortia.

What an NCP Can Do 4 You? (4)

- ✓NCPs at the Academy of Finland are running the competed national research funding calls and this gives a synergetic value for advising the R&I field with the EU calls as well.
- ✓ Business Finland has close cooperation between e.g. Sweden, Norway and Japan which helps to organize other type of international R&D funding not linked to European Commission.
- ✓Knows about the key technology platforms, PPPs and events in EU in advance.
- ✓ Last but not least: <u>no conflicts of interest</u>.

BF PREPARATION FUNDING FOR H2020 CONSORTIA



FINLAND H2020 Project Preparation Funding

Research and Innovation Action (RIA) & Innovation Action (IA)

- ≥ 3 independent entities in 3 different EU MS or Associated Countries
- Funding rate: 70 %, (100 % for non-profit)
- Total EU contribution apprx. 2-5 M€
- Duration: 2-4 years
- Call topics and schedule: See H2020 Work Programme

Fast Track to Innovation (FTI)

- Close to market activities
- Company partners required
- Small consortia: only 3-5 entities in 3 different EU MS
- Funding rate 70 %
- Total EU contribution ≤ 3M€
- Continuously open call with 3 cut-offs every year
- No pre-defined topics
- Projects start at the latest 6 months after the end of the call

BUSINESS FINLAND

A. AS A PART OF A BF PROJECT

- Project preparation activities must be clearly described and included in the appropriate BF funded project's plan (<u>own WP</u>).
- The project plan must also outline how the specific H2020 project would <u>further</u> the ongoing Business Finland project.
- The project plan and budget of an ongoing Business Finland project can also be amended if a related H2020 proposal becomes current. However, adding these activities to an ongoing project will not increase the original Business Finland funding amount.
- Eligible preparation costs must be reasonable in comparison with the potential amount of H2020 funding.

BUSINESS FINLAND B. LARGE H2020 PROJECT PREPARATION FOR SME/MES

- The total budget of the H2020 project must be at least <u>3 million</u> <u>euros</u> and the Finnish participant's role(s) must be financially or otherwise significant (e.g. the coordinator and/or a WP leader).
- Eligible costs for the project preparation phase can be max. 5 % of the Finnish partners' total budget in the proposed projects.
- The application should describe a convincing consortium with the following requirements for FI participation. When an SME or Midcap -company prepares the proposal, at least <u>1 other</u> Finnish participant must be included in the consortium. At least 20% of the total budget of the FI partners in the consortium must go to FI companies. Business Finland funds <u>75 %</u> of eligible costs, maximum grant being <u>50 000 €</u>.
