






Standardized Company – Guatemala City-

Legal form: Corporation (Sociedad Anónima S.A.)

Paid-in minimum capital requirement: GTQ 5,000 / US\$ 680.00

1. Check the company name and obtain a letter from a notary public to open a bank account





4. A notary public completes registration forms and pays the registrations fees online

5. Obtain the certification of the legal representative's registration, the proof of registration at the tax administration office and the edict


